The Garfield Heights Board of Education consists of five members, elected for a period of four years, from the citizens of Garfield Heights, by the registered voters. Two are elected in the year preceding, and three in the year following leap year.

A board of education member serves without pay. His duties, authority, and limitations are prescribed by the state legislature. He is without authority except when the board is in session or, when he is acting under specific instructions of the board.

One of the most important functions of the board of education is the selection of a superintendent of schools. He is the chief executive officer, and is responsible for the selection and assignment of all school employees, the business management

of the schools, the administration and supervision of the educational program, and the assignment of pupils to the various schools. His authority includes the delegation of responsibilities to other qualified employees.

Another important board of education function is the appointment of a clerk-treasurer. He is the chief correspondent and recorder for the board of education. His other responsibilities include those relative to buildings and grounds, and finances.

Our community owes a great debt of gratitude to the members of our board of education for their tremendous contribution of time, effort, and talent to a continuous program of improvement in educational opportunities for our children.




