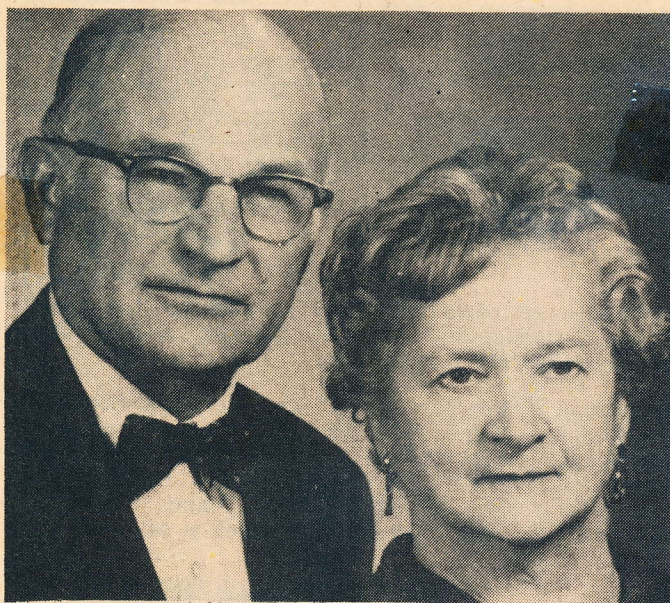

Lindecamps mark 55th wedding anniversary

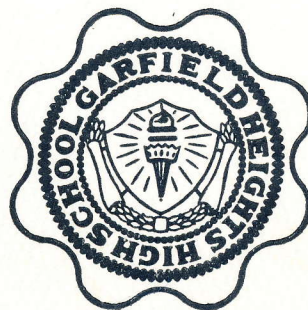
Mr. and Mrs. Charles P. Lindecamp will celebrate their fifty-fifth wedding anniversary tomorrow.

School officials say this do-it-yourself registration system is better than having a large office crew work for days getting everyone sorted out. Registration began yesterday and will continue through tomorrow. All classes are dismissed for the afternoon.

Garfield Heights

High School Students to Choose "Electives" by Teacher and Time

Enrollment for next year's classes at Garfield Heights High School is not unlike college registration. Students are permitted to select elective courses according to teacher, or time, or both.

The result has been a savings in time and paper work for school office forces and a good deal of satisfaction for the students, school officials say.

Administrators have been

able to determine the number of classes that will be needed for each subject following counseling sessions with students earlier in the year.

Based on this information, a list of the courses is made out. Included are the names of the teachers who will instruct in them and the hours the classes will meet.

Homeroom presidents draw lots to determine which

groups get first choice. Students then move around a large room picking out various teachers until their programs are filled.

Once a particular class has all the students it can handle the pupils must make a second or third choice.

This offsets the possibility that teachers with a reputation for being easy will have all the students.

Five Maple Leaf School teachers would like to know if any other suburban school can top their "alumni group."

The quintet of Maple Leaf Elementary School graduates had such a fine time there that they returned to the brick building at 5765 Turney Rd., Garfield Heights, to teach.

Now favorite topics when they meet again in school halls are the changes in their fast-growing community.

Mrs. Lillian Hepworth was the first to return to Maple Leaf. When she began to teach there, 18 years ago, the school contained only six classrooms. They were built in 1925, and an adjacent one-room schoolhouse was built in 1907.

White, kindergarten teacher, and Mrs. Barbara eighth-grade science and math were classmates at Maple Leaf from 1943 to 1946. Both graduated from Garfield Heights High School in 1952. Mrs. Dorothy Bradley attended Garfield Heights High School work in 1949.

Grew to 20 Rooms

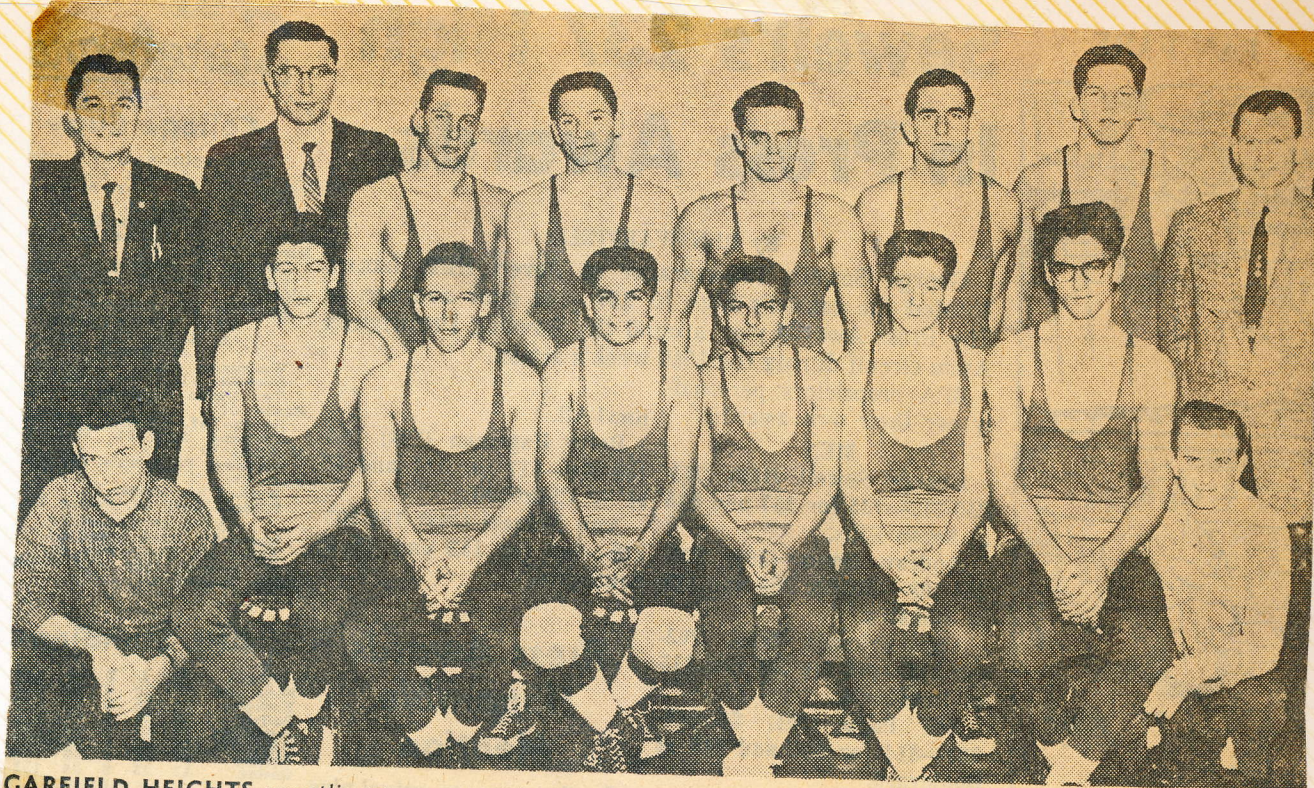
Additions in 1950 and 1953 brought the size to 20 classrooms, with a kindergarten, little theater, gymnasium, offices and special rooms. The one-room schoolhouse was razed when the 1953 addition was made.

Now 25 teachers and the principal, Miss Alice Wiley, supervise 914 students in eight grades. (Garfield Heights schools have eight primary grades and a four-year high school.)

Were Classmates

Fifteen years ago, one of Mrs. Hepworth's most promising second graders was Dan Marsh. Now Marsh teaches math and social studies in seventh and eighth grades.

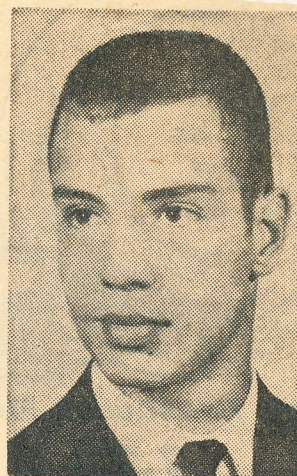

FORMER STUDENT OF MAPLE LEAF

Prof. R. D. McClurg of Lakeland, is dead

Since 1969, Russell D. McClurg had been an associate professor at Lakeland Community College in Kirtland. He taught courses dealing with Western civilization, history and ethnic minorities.

Mr. McClurg, who was 30, died Sunday in Cuernavaca, Mexico. He had been conducting an independent study tour. It is believed he died of a heart attack.

Mr. McClurg, who held bachelor's and master's degrees from John Carroll University, was completing work for a doctorate in history at Kent State University.

He had studied at the London School of Economics in England, Schiller College in Berlin and the Institute for Foreign Languages in Moscow.

He attended a work-study program in government in the White House from 1963 to 1965.

Mr. McClurg had taught at Notre Dame College for Women and had been a visiting lecturer at Lake Erie College.

He lived at 3024 Huntington Rd., Shaker Heights.

Surviving are his parents, Russell W. and Margaret

McClurg, sisters Kathleen Urban and Laureen, and a grandmother, Mrs. Mary Zeisel.

Services will be Friday at 9:30 a.m. in Our Lady of Peace Church, 12503 Buckingham Ave.
